## DARRELL B. BOLIN PROMOTED TO CAPTAIN

Darrell "Blaine" Bolin, a 26-year veteran of the Los Angeles County Sheriff's Department, was recently promoted to Captain by Sheriff Lee Baca and has assumed command of Lomita Station. Lomita Sheriff's Station is responsible for providing law enforcement services to the contract cities of Lomita, Rancho Palos Verdes, Rolling Hills, and Rolling Hills Estates and to the citizens of the unincorporated County areas of La Rambla in San Pedro, and Westfield and The Estates on the Palos Verdes Peninsula.

Captain Bolin's career with the Sheriff's Department began in 1985. After graduating from the Sheriff's Training Academy as a Deputy Sheriff, he worked at the Hall of Justice Jail, and then moved on to a patrol assignment at Carson Station, where he worked various positions. He was promoted to Sergeant in 1995, and was assigned to Pitchess Detention Center, South Facility, before returning to Carson Station. After his promotion to Lieutenant in 2000, Captain Bolin was assigned to Carson Station, Bureau of Labor Relations and Compliance, and Lomita Station.

Captain Bolin holds a Bachelor of Arts Degree in English Literature from California State University, Dominguez Hills.
