In April of 2007 Patrick E. Maxwell was promoted to the rank of Captain by Sheriff Lee Baca and assumed command of the Norwalk Sheriff's Station which serves the cities of La Mirada, Norwalk, and the South Whittier unincorporated area.

Captain Maxwell's career with the Sheriff's Department began in September of 1985 as a Sheriff's Deputy Recruit. Upon graduation from the Academy, he was assigned to Men's Central Jail. He transferred to Lennox Station in 1988 and then worked a variety of assignments including the Gang Enforcement Team and Walnut Sheriff's Station before being promoted to the rank of Sergeant in September of 1994. As a Sergeant, he worked Pitchess North Facility, Norwalk Station, and the Office of the Sheriff. He was promoted to the rank of Lieutenant in April of 2000 and remained at the Office of the Sheriff. In February 2001, he was assigned to the Special Enforcement Bureau and then in November 2003 he moved on to Norwalk Sheriff's Station where he was the Operations Lieutenant.

Captain Maxwell received an Associate of Arts Degree in Administration of Justice from Cerritos College in January 2004 and a Bachelor of Arts Degree in Occupational Studies from California State University-Long Beach in December 2004.
