Captain Jeff Scroggin is a 28 year veteran of the Los Angeles County Sheriff's Department. He was promoted to the rank of Captain by Sheriff Leroy D. Baca on April 13, 2013, and assigned to Walnut / Diamond Bar Station. Captain Scroggin's career with the Sheriff's Department began in 1984. After graduating from the Academy as a Deputy Sheriff, he was assigned to the Inmate Reception Center, Carson Station, the Gang Enforcement Team at Lennox Station, Norwalk Station, and the Training Bureau as a Force Training Instructor. Upon his promotion to Sergeant in 2000, Captain Scroggin was assigned to Industry Station and again to the Training Bureau. Captain Scroggin was promoted to Lieutenant in 2005 and was assigned to Lakewood Station, where he served as the Service Area Lieutenant for the City of Bellflower. In 2008, Captain Scroggin became the Operation's Lieutenant for Norwalk Station. In October 2012, he was assigned to the Executive Offices of the Sheriff, as the Undersheriff's Executive Aide.

Captain Scroggin earned his Master's Degree in Criminal Justice from the University of Cincinnati. He holds a Bachelor's of Science Degree from Cal Poly Pomona in Business Administration and an Associate of Arts Degree in Administration of Justice from Cerritos College.
