

Captain Kent A. Wegener

Kent Wegener, a 33 year veteran of the Los Angeles County Sheriff's Department, was promoted to the rank of Captain and assigned to the Human Trafficking Bureau (HTB) and the Los Angeles Regional Human Trafficking Task Force (LARHTTF). Captain Wegener has been assigned to the Bureau since its inception in 2015.

Captain Wegener's career with the Sheriff's Department began in 1985 with an assignment at the Biscailuz Center Custody Facility.
