MAPAS is accessed by approximately forty County sites over the County's computer network system. The Los Angeles County Sheriff's Department, Court Services Division has the statutory duty to receive, serve, enforce, and return civil process as mandated in the Code of Civil Procedure of the State of California. Sheriff's Court Services Division provides the largest civil process service in the United States. In calendar year 2001, Court Services Division handled approximately 308,000 civil and criminal process. As a result, more than 75 million in court-ordered collections was made and nearly 11 million in fees for service was received. Of those fees, more than 9 million was revenue for the Sheriff's Department. Benefits: The Modified Automated Process and Accounting System (MAPAS) is the computer application that supports Court Services Division's civil process service. MAPAS consists of the following major functions: Case tracking and trust accounting; Management and operational reporting; Court security tracking. MAPAS was developed to meet the following objectives: Reduce and simplify the civil process clerical effort through automation; Provide an automated centralized case file with on-line access to improve the speed and quality of service to the public; Develop common procedures for the civil process service offices; Provide management the information needed for more effective planning and control. Duration: A new MAPAS maintenance agreement was put in place in FY01-02 through the ITSSMA bid process. The maintenance agreement is being extended for two additional fiscal years until terminated after the new system is functioning without deficiencies.
