On February 27, the San Gabriel Valley Regional Chamber of Commerce held its Second Annual Heroes Prayer Breakfast in the City of Diamond Bar. Community leaders, elected officials, and the local business community joined members of the Chamber of Commerce in recognizing local Fire Department, Law Enforcement, Military and EMT "Heroes" for their extraordinary work in the San Gabriel Valley. Throughout 2013, Deputy Mayo reached out and impacted the lives of several people in the community. She assisted in coordinating the Industry Hills Pro Rodeo, an event that has donated nearly \$2 million to special children in need in the greater San Gabriel Valley area. During the winter holidays, Deputy Mayo donated her time and efforts to Viking Charities to make and deliver holiday food baskets to those in need.

Captain Timothy Murakami said "Truly, Deputy Mayo's efforts were deserving of this award. She has consistently gone above and beyond to positively impact the lives of our local community residents."
