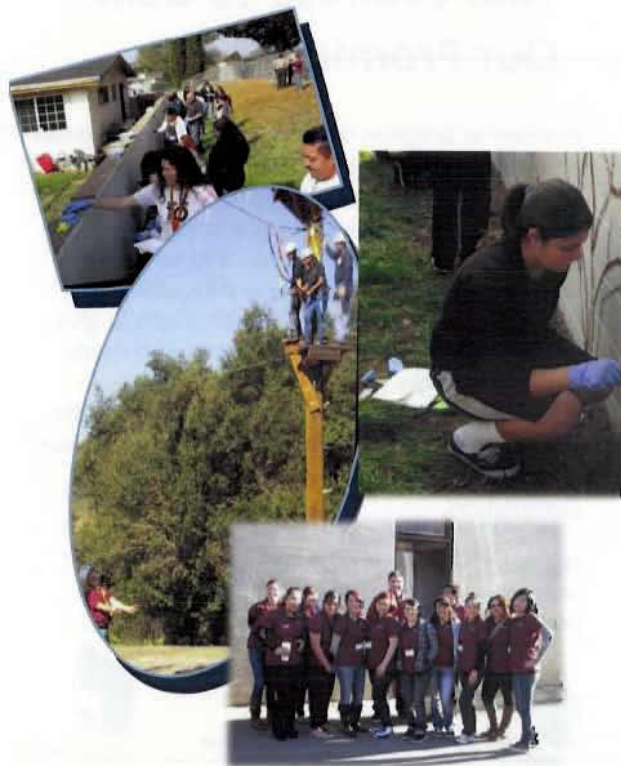




How Can I Sign Up ?

If you would like to donate to our program, please contact us. Your tax deductible contribution will go directly to providing quality programs designed to keep our children gang and drug free.

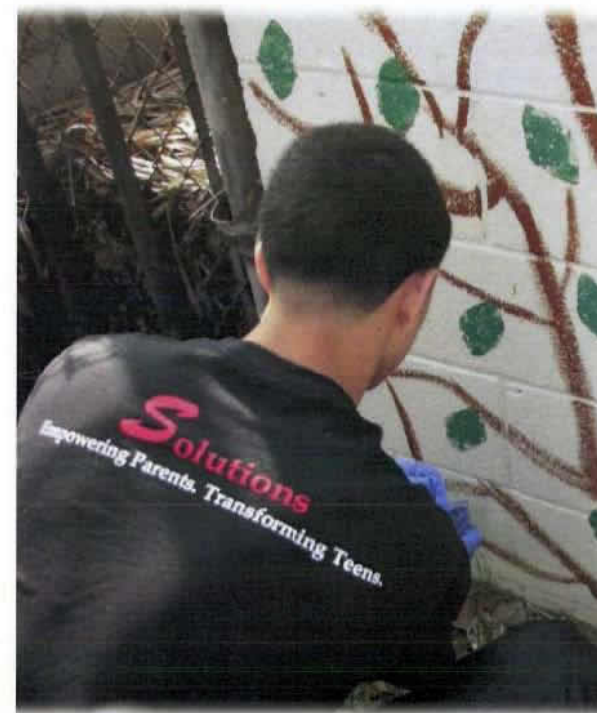

What is Solutions?

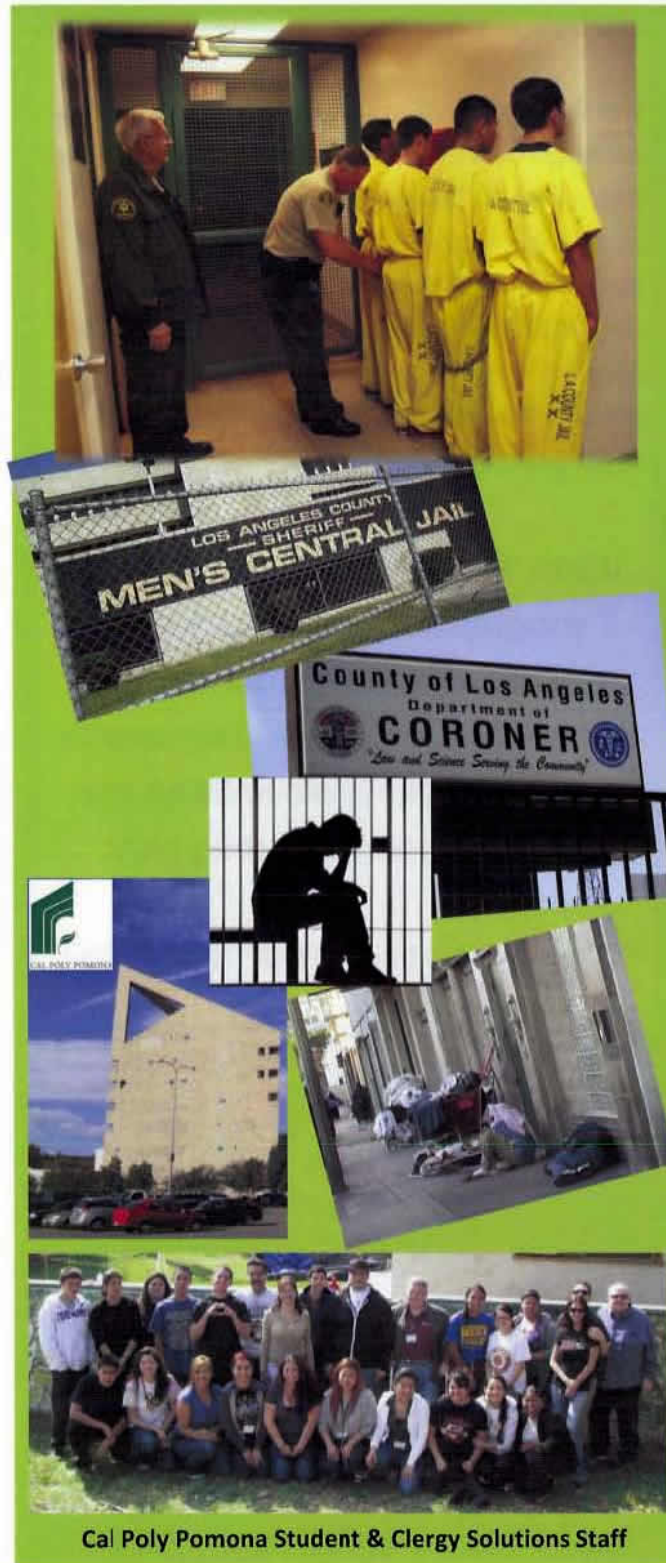

The Solutions program aims to demonstrate to at-risk teens that poor life choices lead to a destructive life style and there are alternatives to joining gangs, committing crimes, and using drugs / alcohol .

In order to enroll in the program, parents **MUST** be willing to attend a 30 hour parenting class taught by trained Parent Project @ facilitators, while their troubled teen attends classes with an assigned college student. These mentors help your teen cope with any difficulties they may be experiencing and teach them to give back to their community. Parents and teens must be present during all of the classes in order to remain enrolled in the program. After successful completion of the program, parents and teens are awarded a Certificate of Completion.

The Solutions programs facilitated by trained professionals, meet court appointed parenting classes.
