Narrative:

On October 17, 2012, Lomita Station deputies responded to the 25800 block Appian Way regarding a Carjacking. The suspect fled the location in the victim's Toyota Sienna toward 259th Street and Walnut Street, where he drove over the sidewalk and struck a MH/Adult who was standing near a doorway to a business in the 1800 block of Pacific Coast Highway.

The suspect abandoned the Toyota Sienna near Western Avenue and 256th Street. He was seen jumping from roof top to roof top by citizens in the area of the 1600 block of 256th Street. The Los Angeles Police Department assisted Lomita Station Deputies during a containment of the suspect. The suspect was seen hiding under a trailer and refused to come out on his own. After the deployment of O.C. Spray and the use of a taser, the suspect complied and was arrested by Lomita Station deputies.

The male victim who was struck by the suspect was taken to a local hospital where he is being treated for his injuries and listed in critical condition.
