Following a major disaster, police, fire and medical professionals may not be able to fully meet the demand. People will have to rely on each other to meet the immediate life saving and life sustaining needs, *particularly* in isolated neighborhoods that may be cut off from the main roads for a period of time.

The County of Los Angeles Fire Department **Community Emergency Response Training (CERT)** program was developed through FEMA to provide basic training in safety and life saving skills for the general public.

The course curriculum covers the following modules:

- *Emergency Preparedness*
- *Fire Safety*
- *Emergency Medical Operations-One victim*
- *Emergency Medical Operations-Triage*
- *Light Search and Rescue Operations*
- *CERT Organization*
- *Disaster Psychology*

- *Disaster Simulation Exercise*
