- 2. Request your current high school transcript. Your application will be incomplete and will not be considered without an official (sealed) transcript. Your transcript should include your class ranking, if available.
- 3. Give the attached Instruction Sheet to each person who agrees to write a letter of recommendation for you. At least one letter should be from a recent teacher or counselor. Please note that letters from relatives will not be accepted. The letters cannot be submitted with the application package. The letters must be faxed to (323) 415-1973 or sent via email to lagallih@lasd.org. The two letters must be received by the deadline date.

The Selection Board will <u>not</u> accept copies of awards, articles, news clippings, etc. The Board-approved student application package will consist of:

- Completed Application, including hard copy verification of SAT and ACT scores. (Copy of scores from College Board will be accepted).
- Official (sealed) transcript
- Two letters of recommendation

NOTE: The letters of recommendation cannot be included with the application and sealed transcript and must be delivered separately via fax or email. If the letters are included with the application and transcript, they will not be accepted and the application will be considered incomplete.

- 5. The deadline for receiving the completed application package (application, sealed transcript and two letters of recommendation) is Friday, March 17, 2017. Applications received after this date will not be accepted.
- 6. The volunteer, all-civilian Scholarship Selection Committee expects to meet in April to choose the finalists and the finalists will be asked to attend personal interviews. The awards ceremony will be held in May 2017.

- 3. Has this student taken a leadership role on campus?
