The Division of Extended Education, in conjunction with the Department of Political Science, offers you an exciting opportunity to get your Master of Science degree in Public Administration in an intensive all-Saturday course format. The program is modeled after Cal State L.A.'s on-campus MSPA program, which is accredited by the National Association of Schools of Public Affairs and Administration (NASPAA).

Designed for employees of the Los Angeles County Sheriff's Department and other professionals, the classes are on Saturdays, from 8:10 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. with a one-hour lunch break and a 30-minute mid-morning and mid-afternoon coffee break. Classes will be taught at STARS Center in Whittier, CA.

As Cal State L.A. students, program participants will have full access to the University library, online databases, and other resources.

### **Entrance Requirements:**

- BA or BS degree
- GPA of 2.75 or better in the last 90-quarter units of undergraduate degree
- Admission to CSULA
- Admission to the Extended Education MSPA Program

### **Additional Requirements:**

- Upon admission, students are required to satisfy the Graduate Writing Assessment Requirement (GWAR).
