The LASDU Scholarships are available now for all full- and part-time law enforcement and emergency services employees. As a Los Angeles Sheriff's Department employee, you're automatically qualified to take advantage of these great benefits.

All courses:

- Consist of rigorous programs that provide relevant job skills
- Follow a one-course-per-month format and can be completed in a month's time

Two Types of Scholarships:

The individual option is a benefit scholarship equal to a 25 percent reduction in tuition fees for full- and part-time law enforcement and emergency services employees engaged in a course of study aimed toward earning an associate's, bachelor's, or master's degree or certification*.

The cohort option is a benefit scholarship equal to a 40 percent reduction in tuition fees when a group of 15 or more students take a program together. Note that this scholarship is available to all full- and part-time law enforcement and emergency services employees as well as their immediate family members. Programs offered as a cohort include*:
