BULLETIN NO. 1 REQUEST FOR STATEMENT OF QUALIFICATIONS (RFSQ) POLYGRAPH EXAMINATION SERVICES RFSQ NO. PES – 333-2007

INTRODUCTION

The Los Angeles County Sheriff's Department (Department) is issuing this Request for Statement of Qualifications (RFSQ) to solicit qualified Contractors who can provide pre-employment Polygraph Examination Services to the Department's Scientific Services Bureau on an intermittent and temporary basis. The solicitation will remain open until the Department's needs are met.

MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS

Interested and qualified Contractors that can demonstrate their ability to successfully provide the required services outlined in Appendix B, Statement of Work, are invited to submit their Statement of Qualifications (SOQ) provided they meet the following requirements:

- Contractor must have successfully graduated from a formal polygraph training course, recognized and accredited by the American Polygraph Association, California Association of Polygraph Examiners, or the American Association of Police Polygraphists.
- 2. Contractor must be currently active in the administration of polygraph examinations. To qualify for this status, the Contractor must meet one of the following criteria:

A Tradition of Service Since 1850

- a. Minimum of one (1) year experience within the last three (3) years in conducting polygraph examinations for a public law enforcement agency. This experience must have included conducting a minimum of one hundred (100) polygraph exams for a law enforcement agency or agencies, twenty-five (25) of which must have been within the last two (2) years, or
- b. Contractor must be a full-time instructor at an accredited polygraph school for a minimum of two (2) years within the last three (3) years.
- 3. Contractor must be a current member, in good standing, with one of the following professional polygraph examiner associations and have attended a minimum of 16 hours of training sponsored by one of these organizations in the last three (3) years:
 - American Polygraph Association
 - California Association of Polygraph Examiners
 - American Association of Policy Polygraphists
- 4. Contractor must be proficient in the use of the Lafayette computerized polygraph instrument currently in use by the Department.
- 5. Contractor must pass with a score of 80% the polygraph proficiency test consisting of general polygraph knowledge, question formulation, chart analysis, and instrumentation. The test is included in the RFSQ documents, Appendix C (Required Forms), Exhibit 12, and is to be completed and submitted with the SOQ.

No facsimile (fax) or electronic mail (e-mail) copies will be accepted. Any SOQ not received by the deadline date may not be reviewed initially; however, they may be reviewed at a later date to determine if they meet the qualifications listed. This solicitation will remain open until the Sheriff has executed sufficient Agreements to meet the Department's needs.
