# BULLETIN NUMBER 1 INVITATION FOR BIDS (IFB) CAREER TECHNICAL EDUCATION AND LIFE SKILLS COURSES IFB NUMBER 664-SH

#### INTRODUCTION

The County of Los Angeles (County), Sheriff's Department (Department), is issuing this Invitation for Bids (IFB) to solicit bids for a Contract with a qualified school district, adult education institution, charter school, county office of education, career and technical college, community college, university, institution, non-profit organization, or other education institution (Bidder) that can provide Career Technical Education and Life Skills Courses to inmates incarcerated in the Department's custody facilities.

The goals of the Department's inmate education program are to improve the quality of life of participating inmates, increase safety in the custody facilities through education and training, and reduce recidivism. The Department's average daily inmate population is approximately 18,000.

#### BIDDER'S MINIMUM MANDATORY REQUIREMENTS

Interested and qualified Bidders that can demonstrate their ability to successfully provide the required services outlined in Appendix B (Statement of Work) of the IFB are invited to submit bids, provided they meet the following minimum mandatory requirements:

Bidder's confirmation shall be evidenced by Bidder's affirmative statement required by subparagraph 2.8.3 (Bidder's Qualification (Section B.1)) of the IFB and Bidder's certification set forth in the completed Exhibit 1 (Bidder's Organization Questionnaire/Affidavit and CBE Information) of Appendix D (Required Forms) of the IFB.

3. Bidder's instructors must meet the minimum qualifications as stated in Attachment B.3 (Instructor Duties and Minimum Qualifications for Career Technical Education Courses) and Attachment B.4 (Instructor Duties and Minimum Qualifications for Life Skills Courses) of Appendix B (Statement of Work) of the IFB.

- Bidder shall provide supporting documentation to verify credentials, and/or certifications, and/or proof of experience, for each of Bidder's instructors to meet this minimum mandatory requirement.
- 4. Bidders must be regionally or nationally accredited. Accreditation must be recognized by the United States Department of Education.
  - Bidder shall provide supporting documentation to meet this minimum mandatory requirement.
- 5. Bidders must have two (2) years prior experience working inside a custody environment or experience working with ex-offenders.
  - Bidder shall provide references that verify this minimum mandatory requirement which shall include start dates, end dates, agency names, and services provided.
- 6. If Vendor's compliance with a County contract has been reviewed by the Department of Auditor-Controller within the last ten (10) years, Vendor must not have unresolved questioned costs identified by the Auditor-Controller, in an amount over \$100,000, that are confirmed to be disallowed costs by the contracting County department, and remain unpaid for six (6) months or more from the date of disallowance, unless such disallowed costs are the subject of current good faith negotiations to resolve the disallowed costs, in the opinion of the County.

The original bid and three (3) numbered exact hard copies, and two (2) separate electronic copies in pdf format on flashdrives or compact discs, shall be enclosed in a sealed envelope or box, plainly marked in the upper left-hand corner with the name and address of the Bidder and bear the words:

It is the sole responsibility of the submitting Bidder to ensure that its bid is received before the submission deadline. Submitting Bidders shall bear all risks associated with delays in delivery by any person or entity, including the U.S. Mail. Any bids received after the scheduled closing date and time for receipt of bids, as listed in subparagraph 2.3 (IFB Timetable) of the IFB, will not be accepted and returned to the sender unopened. Timely hand-delivered bids are acceptable. No facsimile (fax) or electronic mail (e-mail) copies will be accepted.

All bids shall be firm offers and may not be withdrawn for a period of two hundred and seventy (270) Business Days following the last day to submit bids.
