RE: ADDENDUM NUMBER ONE TO RFP# ISAB005 (RFP) FOR MULTIMODAL BIOMETRIC IDENTIFICATION SYSTEM (MBIS) SOLUTION

This Addendum Number One to RFP# ISAB005 (RFP) for Multimodal Biometric Identification System (MBIS) Solution is issued by the County of Los Angeles (County) through its Information System Advisory Body (ISAB). A copy of this Addendum shall be e-mailed to each person or organization that submitted a "notice of Intent to Respond" by August 13, 2013, in addition to being posted on County's Open Bids and Solicitations portal at:

Unless defined in this Addendum, any term with initial letter capitalized shall have the meaning given to such term in the RFP.

This Addendum revises certain sections of the RFP for clarification and modifies the RFP timetable as specified below.

i. The timetable in Section 2.5 (RFP Timetable) of the RFP is revised to read as follows:

Release of RFP	July 30, 2013
Request for Solicitation Requirements Review Due (10 Business Days after release of RFP)	August 13, 2013
Notice of Intent to Respond	August 13, 2013
Written Questions Due	August 26, 2013
Questions and Answers Released	September 10, 2013
Proposals Due (5:00 p.m. Pacific Time)	September 27, 2013

ii. A Minimum Mandatory Requirement is clarified in Item 3 under Section 1.4 (Minimum Mandatory Requirements) of the RFP, which is revised to read as follows:

- Proposers must be established prime manufacturers of AFIS systems with equivalent AFIS installations (equivalent in terms of AFIS functionality, database size, transaction throughput and identification accuracy) that are in current productive use in U.S. law enforcement installations. Proposals will not be accepted from third-party manufacturer representatives, system integrators or from manufacturers whose systems do not meet the equivalency requirements and productive use requirements established in this solicitation. Proposers must have implemented their solutions in at least two public safety/law enforcement environments of similar size and complexity to that of the County within the last five (5) years.

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iii. A typographical error is corrected and the Minimum Mandatory Requirement is clarified in Item 3 under Section 1.4 (Minimum Mandatory Requirements) of the RFP, which is revised to read as follows:

3. Proposer has a mature AFIS solution that has been in live production for a minimum of three (3) years.

All other terms and conditions of the RFP shall remain unchanged.
