EDUCATION-BASED DISCIPLINE

The mission of Education-Based Discipline is to develop an individualized remedial plan, with the involvement of the employee, that emphasizes education, training and other creative interventions, thereby promoting a more comprehensive and successful outcome.

Education-Based Discipline (EBD) is an innovative alternative to traditional disciplinary suspensions. EBD reduces management-employee conflict and embitterment that results from withholding employees' pay. Instead, offering optional behavior-focused education and training department-wide, enhances communication, character, competence and trust. EBD ensures the continued development of our workforce and service excellence.

EBD is a voluntary option to disciplinary suspensions. All rights are preserved while employees decide between suspension of pay or EBD.
